Our project of acquiring a second MRI scanner for Saint-Jérôme and region is under way! Thanks to our donors and partners, we are well on our way to achieving our objective of \$2 000 000.



BACKGROUND

The CISSS des Laurentides (the Laurentian regional health authority) operates 2 MRI medical imaging machines, 24 hours a day. These sophisticated devices are unable to meet the needs of our growing population and some patients must wait 9-12 months for this type of diagnostic analysis.

The professional medical staff at the Laurentian regional health authority has undertaken a detailed analysis of our needs for imaging technology and the increasing demands of our population. They have recommended the purchase of an additional MRI scanner.

OUR OBJECTIVE

Magnetic Resonance Imaging or MRI is a sophisticated medical device that allows our medical professionals to explore the inside of the body with precision, producing a detailed image of various organs and tissues such as muscles and tendons, the cardio-vascular and neurological systems, , the spinal column, tumors, etc...

The acquisition of an additional MRI imaging device for the Laurentians will lead to faster diagnoses of our patients, faster corrective clinical actions and better medical outcomes for our population. And that, without travelling to more distant urban centres.
